NJ Schools Win With Free Electronic Recycling

Ogdensburg, NJ. Ever since a free electronic recycling program was instituted in Sussex County, in less than 5 months time, schools have recycled close to fifteen thousand pounds of retired computer equipment and peripherals.

Working closely with Sussex County Municipal Authority officials and school buildings and grounds professionals, Back Thru The Future (BTTF), an electronic equipment recycling company based in Ogdensburg, established the pilot program in January 2007. BTTF recognized it could easily accommodate the schools in their efforts to be responsible environmentalists.

“The free recycling project for Sussex County Schools has done so well, we have decided to extend the boundaries to all New Jersey Schools”, says BTTF president, Melanie Haga. She adds, “School budgets don’t usually cover costs associated with meeting state regulatory requirements for electronic equipment recycling and our company wanted to step up and be part of a solution.”

As long as schools make an appointment and deliver the equipment to BTTF, the free program covers whole computer units including monitors, printers, fax machines, typewriters, cables, keyboards and peripherals. It also covers laptops, copiers, UPS (batteries), PDAs, cell phones and network equipment. For a fee, and if requested, physical data destruction is available for hard drives, cds, zip disks and backup media.
